Educational Supervisors guidance for supporting Registrars transitioning

Is there a new ePortfolio (with the 2015 curriculum Learning Outcomes)? How can I get access?

There isn't a "new" ePortfolio, we have been updating Registrars accounts to display the 2015 learning outcomes. As an Educational Supervisor you do not need to have your account updated to display the 2015 Learning Outcomes.

What does transitioning on the ePortfolio mean for Registrars?

This is the process by which Registrars will record their progress on the 2010 curriculum on the ePortfolio and then transfer this to the ePortfolio with 2015 Learning Outcomes displayed.

What do I have to do as an Educational supervisor for this process?

You will only need to sign off one item in the ePortfolio. Your Registrars should have mapped their progress on the 2010 curriculum to the 2015 curriculum. Then they record this on their Transition Progress Log, which is submitted attached to an Activity summary sheet for your approval. If you are happy that this is an accurate record of their progress you will approve. Then the process is complete.

Do all my Registrars have to transition?

No. Only those who are signing off 2010 curriculum learning Outcomes on the ePortfolio.

My Registrar has been using a paper based system to sign off leaning outcomes. Can we still do this instead of transitioning to the new ePortfolio?

1. For Registrars who will CCT before the 31st August 2018 there is the option to continue to use paper record of training if preferred otherwise. If a Registrar is finishing training after this date it is expected that they are to use the system unless agreed with the local Training Programme Director.
2. For Registrars approaching an ARCP in the next 12 months there is an option to have a hybrid approach (for example use of paper based record for the year from last ARCP and preceding the access to e portfolio and use of ePortfolio subsequent to access to e portfolio to next upcoming ARCP (all registrars should have access by May 2017)).
3. After their next ARCP registrars should aim to use the ePortfolio to record training.

All preferences should be discussed and agreed with local your TPD.

But I have some Registrars on the 2010 curriculum who are finishing training soon. Do they have to transition to the 2015 curriculum?

If they are completing training before August 31 2017 we would not expect them to transfer.

What will I see when I log on?

When you log in go to the "As Educational Supervisor" field and then view "All LOSOS" approved, rejected or submitted for approval by your Registrars. Now you will see these split by curriculum. This will be the same as when viewing the "Outstanding LOSOS" page. Please see the screenshots below.
