## Diplomate Membership DFPH

### Eligibility

Automatic eligibility to election to Diplomate membership on passing Part A of the FPH Membership examination. Candidates who have passed Part I of the Examination for Membership of the Faculty of Public Health Medicine of the Royal College of Physicians, Ireland may claim exemption from Part A of the MFPH examination and are eligible for Diplomate membership.

## Membership MFPH

### Eligibility

#### Membership by examination

Candidates who have passed both the Part A and Part B of FPH's membership examination are eligible for full membership of FPH.
