Eligibility

Fellowship via membership or via exemption

FPH's highest membership grade, members and non-members are eligible for election to Fellowship by the Board when they have been accepted onto the Specialist Registers of the GMC, GDC or UKPHR.

Fellowship through distinction

FPH has an annual proposal round for candidates who are ineligible for fellowship via membership or exemption routes.
