Comfort aids that must be provided by testing centre:

Earplugs

Headphones

Tissues/Kleenex

Medicine & Medical Devices:

Auto-injectors; such as EpiPen

Bandages

Braces: neck, back, wrist, leg or ankle braces

Casts: including slings for broken/sprained arms and other injury-related items that cannot be removed

*Cough drops: must be unwrapped and not in a bottle/container

*Eye drops

Eye patches

**Eyeglasses with or without a frame (without the case)

Hand-held (non-electronic) magnifying glass (without the case)

Hearing aids

Inhaler

Medical alert bracelet, including medical alert bracelets with USB ports. TAs will file an IR if they notice any unusual behaviour with a candidate wearing a medical alert bracelet with USB port.

Medical device attached to a person's body, including but not limited to, insulin pump, TENS Unit, or spinal cord stimulator. TAs will file an IR if a candidate uses this aid.

Medical/surgical face mask

Pillow/cushion

*Pills (e.g. Tylenol or aspirin) must be unwrapped and not in a bottle/container. Candidates may bring pills that are still in the packaging if the packaging states they must remain in the packaging, such as nitro glycerin pills that cannot be exposed to air. Packaging must be properly inspected.

- * Marked comfort aids are not allowed in the testing room. These items must be stored preferably within the candidate's locker or if required stored on the invigilators desk. Candidates must exit the testing room to use these items.
- ** Eyeglasses with frames are the only comfort aids that test administrators may ask candidates to remove
