To start the tutorial, type https://app.testreach.com/system-requirements/ in your browser and log in with the credentials for your chosen stylesheet.

The FPH Diplomate Functionality Test is now embedded in the TestReach Tutorial which can be accessed via the TestReach app.

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FPH Functionality Familiarisation Test

FPH offer candidates the chance to try out the functionality that you will see in your customised Diplomate exam canvas. Past Diplomate Exam questions have been included as example content.

As the Functionality Familiairsation Test is now incorporated within the tutorial there is no longer an attempt limit.

Some points to note:

- The exam paper has a set time duration of 2½ hours. Please note that you can re-enter the TestReach tutorial and re-start the Functionality Test as many times as you wish.
- There will not be a remote invigilator element for this trial exam and your answers will not be marked.
- The paper will consist of four questions one Paper IA question, one Paper IIA question (with a word limit feature enabled) and two Paper IIB questions.
- The Paper IIA question appears with a word count feature enabled (set to 660 words). You can add text in excess of 660 words, but the background will change to red to indicate that you have exceeded the word limit. In the live exam, examiners will not mark any text after the point where the script exceeds 660 words.

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- The word count feature will also be enabled in the live exam. Please note that this is the only question that has a word count limit. In the live exam this will be on Paper IIA, Question 1.
- Please note that the Functionality Familiairsation Test is intended as a tool to familiarise yourself with the functionality of the online exam canvas ahead of the live exam. It is not intended to be a mock exam.
