Members and Fellows who have retired full time or part time from Public Health work are eligible for retired rates. Our rates are based on how much you earn each year from public health related work and does not include any other source of income, including pension.	

### Please note:

- 1) You will be asked to confirm that you have retired fully or are semi-retired from public health work.
- 2) You are required to inform FPH if you later take up paid work, in which case depending on your income from paid work, either the appropriate reduced income linked retired rate would apply or the normal Member or Fellow rates would apply which may include salary linked reductions.
- 3) If you take up lifetime membership and then return to paid public health work, you must inform FPH as you may be required to revert to annual paid membership and no refund will be given for the lump sum lifetime fee that has already been paid. However, if/when that paid public health work ceases you will return to Lifetime Membership, and no additional fee will be required.
