


The problem

Ill health is having an acute impact on living standards


Number of adults aged 16-64 who are economically inactive due to long-term sickness: UK

Proportion of working-age adults who are economically inactive due to ill health, by single year of age: UK



Economic circumstances can also influence health





Rolling decadal growth rate of real GDP per capita: GB/UK



Rolling decadal growth rates of real GDP per capita and real wages: GB/UK




Gini coefficient for equivalised disposable household income (after housing costs): UK

Cumulative change in CPI price level since September 2021, by spending category: UK




Proportion of respondents reporting various health consequences, by financial situation: UK, 6-13 March 2023



Proportion of young people in Year 13 (aged 17-18) who sought mental health support and were still waiting/never got support, by IMD income quintile and form of support: England, 2022




Proportion of young people in Year 13 (aged 17-18) who sought mental health support and were still waiting/never got support, by IMD income quintile and form of support: England, 2022










Highest qualification level of 18-24-year-olds, by current economic status (excluding full-time students): UK, 2020-2022



Entering work is the best way of lifting people out of poverty...


Proportion of people in in-work poverty households in 2014-15 who escaped poverty in 2017-18, by change in circumstances: UK





Gross fixed capital formation as a proportion of GDP: selected advanced economies




To boost productivity, we need to be an investment nation – across both private and public sector

Real value of unemployment benefits as a proportion of average weekly earnings: UK


